IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

Please read carefully and follow instructions closely in order to avoid mistakes and confusion.

- a) Closing date for entries is **MONDAY 26th March 2018 by 9pm. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- b) We realise that some of the names on your entries might change after this date. Providing the changes are notified to the Office this will cause no problem.
- c) All competing members must have **VALID MEMBERSHIP CARDS INCLUDING A PHOTO.** If new membership cards are required, the membership forms must be received by the Office with the returned entry form by **Monday 26th March.**
- d) Two sets of schedules are enclosed for each Club. A booklet set is for the Club Secretary's reference and the A4 stapled set is for dismantling and passing on rules to the competing members, you may need to copy extra.
- e) One entry form is enclosed per Club. This is for completion and to be returned to the County Office by the deadline, you can make a copy for your records in the back of the booklet copy where the entry form is included or please ask for a spare form to fill in. You can also complete an online copy from email or the website.
- f) All rules and entry forms are emailed to Club Chairmen and Secretaries in advance and posted out if not collected from the Office by a Club representative.
- g) Any trophies relating to this competition held by any Club member must be returned to the County Office by the above deadline date along with the entry forms and no later than the Monday of the competition week.

STOCKJUDGING (SENIOR SECTION) - Sunday 29th April 2018

1. This competition is open to **FOUR** members per class per Club 26 years of age or under on 1st September 2017. Each competitor will be required to place and give reasons on a minimum of ONE and maximum of THREE of the following stock:

Class S7 BEEF Four Commercial Cattle

Class S8 SHEEP Four Breeding Ewes

Class S9 PIGS Four Butchers Pigs

Sheep to be judged as **Commercial Breeding Stock**. Beef and Pigs as **Commercial Butchers Animals**

2. Competitors will be allowed **TEN** minutes to view, handle and place each ring. Senior competitors are also required to give **PLACINGS ONLY** on the Intermediate ring and will be allowed TEN minutes to view, handle and place this ring. Competitors to note that if only one ring of stock is available for any of the stockjudging classes then the placing mark for that ring will be multiplied by two.
3. Competitors will be allowed two minutes in which to state their reasons to the Judge. Reasons should be comparative rather than descriptive. Whilst stating reasons competitors will be permitted to consult any notes they may have made on the cards provided, but reasons without frequent reference to notes will carry greater weight with the Judge when awarding marks.
4. Competitors taking more than the allotted time for their reasons will be penalised by the deduction of 2 marks for every 15 seconds or part thereof over time.

CLASS 10

FENCE ERECTING - Sunday 29th April 2018

Booking In Time 1.30pm to start at 2.00pm

1. Each Club may enter **TWO TEAMS OF THREE** members. A team shall consist of three members, one member shall be 21 years of age or under on 1 September 2017 and two members shall be 26 years of age or under on 1 September 2017 and full members of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC.
 - i. All competitors will be required to produce on the day of each round of the competition (County, Area, Region and NFYFC final) their current, **signed** NFYFC membership card that has the members' photograph properly attached.
 - ii. **Spirit of fair competition within YFC.** All YFC members are reminded that (under rule 6 of the Club Constitution document) they can represent only **one** Club when participating in NFYFC competitions in a year (01 September to 31 August). This rule applies to all competitions – members can only compete for the same single Club throughout the year. The rule should be applied by County Federations – members can represent only one YFC Club at the district/county rounds of the competitions throughout the year. This maintains the spirit of fair competition within YFC.
2. **SUBSTITUTION**
 - a. If two or more of the original team are unable to go forward to subsequent rounds, then the next highest placed team will represent the Area.
 - b. **All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.**
3. **HEALTH & SAFETY & SAFEGUARDING**
 - a. All competitions carried out at every level must comply with Health and Safety and Safeguarding legislation and meet the relevant safety standards.

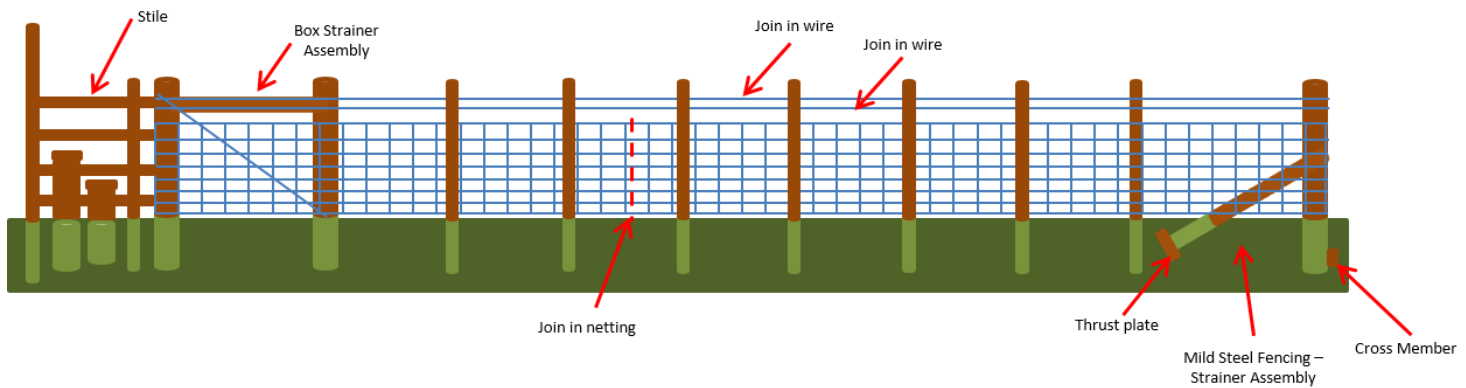
HEALTH & SAFETY – ESSENTIAL READING/ACTION FOR ALL COMPETITORS

It is essential that all competitors read the Health and Safety Executive's guidance paper concerning fencing and note is taken of the safe working practices and protective clothing equipment that is recommended. The Health and Safety Executive guidance paper 'Fencing' (AFAG104) can be downloaded from the NFYFC website.

4. PROCEDURE

- a. The team will be required to erect a stock proof boundary fence, with an adjoining stile at one end using the materials provided (as illustrated in the diagram).
- b. The fence shall be 22 metres in a straight line, constructed of post and netting with 2 strands of plain mild steel wire above the netting. It shall have a normal mild steel fencing strainer assembly at one end; and a box strainer assembly at the other.
- c. The stile shall be in addition to the 22 metres at one end built to BS5709:2006. It shall have a minimum width between the upright stile posts of 1.2 metres. The stile shall have a lower step and higher step.
- d. The plain wire must be tensioned and tied with a knot at both ends. In addition, a join in each strand must be made using hand tied knots, where indicated on the diagram.
- e. A join in the netting must be made by hand (no gripples/crimps) where shown on the diagram.
- f. At one end the normal mild steel fencing strainer assembly shall be constructed using a strainer and diagonal strut (strut secured using a thrust plate, and strainer secured using a cross member).
- g. At the other end of the fence (same end as the stile) there must be a box strainer with a horizontal strut; and a mild steel diagonal tie.
- h. The team are required to prepare a written risk assessment/method statement, which is to be handed to the Chief Steward on the day of the competition - prior to the competition start. *Failure to provide a written risk assessment/method statement or failure to comply with it; or working unsafely, will result in immediate disqualification. Please see NFYFC Fence Erecting Risk Assessment Template below. This may be used and completed as teams wish (Risk 1 already entered as an example).*

***Diagram is not to scale and is for illustrative purposes only
All spacing's to be determined by the competitors***



- i. Only hand tools will be allowed and the teams themselves must provide these. No power tools or chainsaws are allowed.
 - i. All tools and equipment used must be fit for purpose and be in good condition, well maintained and safely operated by members of the team at all times. Judges/stewards have the right to stop the use of tool/piece of equipment if, in their view, it is not safe to use or is being handled/used in an unsafe manner.
 - j. Competitors are not allowed to shorten any of the vertical posts.
 - k. The Judge reserves the right to inspect any strut following completion of the task.
 - l. All teams are required to dismantle their fence after the Presentation of Awards (The thrust plate and any blocks/cross members must be out of the ground). Teams are required to clear away all debris and any off-cuts of wire etc must **not** be put down the postholes. Receptacles will be provided for this purpose. Soil will be available to make the ground good.
 - m. The Judge's decision is final.

n. List of Items to be provided:

- 3 x Strainers: 2.2m, 125mm – 150mm diameter round posts (7ft, 5" – 6")
- 1 x Diagonal Strut: From 1.8m x 100mm diameter round post (6ft, 3 – 4")
- 1 x Horizontal Strut: From 2.4m x 100mm diameter round post (8ft, 3 – 4")
- 7 x Intermediate posts: 1.7m x 100mm diameter round posts (5ft 6", 3 – 4")
- Stile Vertical posts: 1 x 1.8m x 100mm diameter round post (6ft, 3 – 4")
1 x 2.4m x 100mm diameter round post (8ft, 3 – 4")
- 4 x Horizontal Stile Rails: From 2 x 3.6m x 100mm x 47mm square (12ft, 4" x 2")
- 2 x Stile Steps + 2 x Taller Stile Step supports
From 1 x 4.8m x 200mm x 47mm square (16ft, 8" x 2")
- 2 x Shorter Stile Step supports
From 1 x 2.4m x 200mm x 47mm square (8ft, 8" x 2")
- 1 x Thrust Plate + 1 x Cross Member:
From 1 x 0.9m x 100mm x 47mm square (3ft, 4" x 2")
- 25m x mild steel stock netting C8/80/15
- 60m x mild steel plain wire
- 4" nails
- Staples

5. TIMING

- a. Two hours thirty minutes (**2 hours and 30 minutes**) will be allowed.
- b. Time penalties – teams will be encouraged to complete the task but will lose one (**1**) **point** per minute over the allocated time

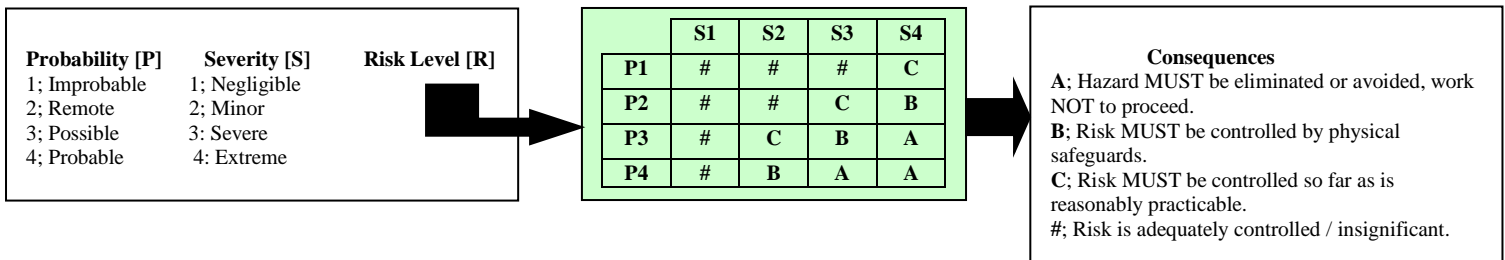
