GENERAL RULES

1. All competitors must be current (2018-19) members of Herefordshire or Radnorshire YFC's. Competitors will be required to show their membership cards. Failure to do so will result in a £5 on the spot penalty charge.
2. A white coat must be worn, unless otherwise specified. Competitors not wearing white coats when they should be will be deducted 10 points from their final mark.
3. For the purposes of this schedule, the following age limits will apply:
Senior – open to member 26 years of age and under on 1st September 2018
Intermediate – open to members 21 years of age and under on 1st September 2018
Junior – open to members 16 years of age and under on 1st September 2018, and 10 years of age or over on the day of the competition.
4. All members must have valid membership cards with photo and signature. Members with cards that have expired or with no photo will not be allowed to compete (for insurance reasons).
5. Competitors must arrive on time and report to the competition steward before the start time of the competition to book in with necessary equipment to complete the competition. See rule 6 regarding the procedure if a competitor is going to be late to their competition. Any competitor arriving late without prior notification may be penalised, at the discretion of the judge.
6. Each club is to appoint their own Chief Steward – a non-competing person who will be responsible for informing competition Stewards and Announcers if a competitor is late reporting for a competition or won't be reporting at all. This person's name and contact details are to be included on the entry form.
7. Special requirements – if any member has any special requirements when competing, then please do not hesitate to contact the County Office in order that the necessary provisions may be implemented, ideally at least a week prior to the competition.
8. Competitors may not communicate with each other or with members of the public whilst competitions are ongoing or whilst in the stockjudging rings, at penalty of disqualification. Competitors will receive one warning from the steward, after which any incident shall be reported to the judge.
9. In all competitions, the decision of the judge is final. No harassment may be given to the judge or steward by any YFC member or member of the public, at penalty of disqualification.
10. All trestle tables will be 6 or 8 foot.
11. All exhibits must be left on view to the public until 5pm, when they can be removed. If removed before 5pm, clubs will be placed 20 points below the lowest placed club in that competition.
12. Herefordshire and Radnorshire Federations will not be held responsible for any items left on display after 6pm.
13. Members turning up late for the first competition of the day will be given no extra time to complete the competition. There will be zero tolerance on this rule.
14. No electric will be available for competitors on the day.

RULES REGARDING TOTAL DISQUALIFICATION

- A) If a competitor is found to be over the stated age, this will lead to total disqualification
- B) The County Chairman, County Vice-Chairman, Competitions Chairman and Competition Vice-Chairman have the right to disqualify any competitor they feel is under the influence of alcohol or other substances.
- C) Any infringement of the rules will result in a competitor being placed at the bottom with a difference of 10 points to the next highest placed competitor.
- D) Any complaints to be received in writing by the Competitions Chairman and accompanied by £20 within one hour of the alleged grievance. A panel of the County Chairman, County Vice-Chairman, Competitions Chairman, Competitions Vice-Chairman and the competition judges(s) and steward(s) (if available) will give ruling. If the complaint is upheld the £20 will be refunded.

AWARDS

The Major HEB Holden Perpetual Challenge Cup will be awarded to the club gaining the highest aggregate marks in all competitions.

The Messrs J & P Turner Ltd Perpetual Challenge Cup will be awarded to the winning team in class 1.

The Hector Morris Challenge Cup will be awarded to the club gaining the highest aggregate marks in the home craft section (classes 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11).

Prize Cards will be awarded to the 3 highest placed scorers in each competition.

ENTRY FEE & FORMS

An **Entry Fee of £20.00** entitles a club to enter all classes and is to be sent with the entry form to Herefordshire YFC Office.

The federation can accept CASH or CHEQUE Payment. **Cheques** to be made payable to:

COMPETITION RULES

CLASS 1 STOCKJUDGING - BEEF, SHEEP AND LAMB CARCASE (PLACINGS ONLY)

9:30AM

Open to up to 3 teams of 2 members. One member aged 26 years and under, one aged 16 years and under on 1st September 2018. Each competitor will be required to give placings on rings of each of the following animals:

- A. 4 Beef Cattle
- B. 4 Sheep
- C. Carcase

Team 'A's' points will count toward the YFC shield.

The animals will be designated A, B, X and Y, and competitors will be allowed 10 minutes to view, handle and place.

Total Marks: 300 per team

CLASS 2 STOCKJUDGING – BEEF CATTLE

9:30AM

Open to one team of two competitors per club, one aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018 and one aged 18 years and under on 1st September 2018. Each competitor will be required to judge one ring of FOUR BUTCHERS BEASTS and place in order of merit. The animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. Competitors will be allowed 10 minutes to view, handle and place in the ring, and 2 minutes to state their reasons to the judge. 2 marks per 15 seconds (or part thereof) will be deducted from the total score if this time limit is exceeded.

CLASS 3 STOCKJUDGING – SHEEP

9:30AM

Open to one team of two competitors per club, one aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018 and one aged 18 years and under on 1st September 2018. Each competitor will be required to judge one ring of FOUR FAT LAMBS and place in order of merit. The animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. Competitors will be allowed 10 minutes to view, handle and place in the ring, and 2 minutes to state their reasons to the judge. 2 marks per 15 seconds (or part thereof) will be deducted from the total score if this time limit is exceeded.

“100 YEARS SINCE ARMISTICE”

CLASS 4 – UNDER 18 FLORAL ART

11:00AM

Open to one member per club aged 18 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors will be required to make an exhibit to the theme ‘Peace’, to be viewed from the front. Maximum space allowed = 60cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height. An Exhibit to compose of natural plant material with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified above. All arrangements to be assembled during the competition. Competitors to bring their own materials, equipment, etc. Maximum time allowed = 60 minutes, with a further 10 minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during clearing-up.

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 5 – UNDER 26 FLORAL ART

11:00AM

Open to one member per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors will be required to make a memorial wreath. Maximum space allowed = 60cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height. Wreath to be composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified above. All arrangements to be assembled during the competition. Competitors to bring their own materials, equipment, etc. Maximum time allowed = 60 minutes, with a further 10 minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during setup.

CLASS 6 – SCRAPBOOK (staged)

9:30AM

Each club to bring their 2017/18 scrapbook for display purposes only, for which 100 points will be awarded

CLASS 7 – HANDWRITING

10:30AM

Open to one member per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors are required to hand write the first 2 verses of the World War 1 poem ‘In Flanders Fields’ by John McCrae on A4 paper or card prior to the competition day. Competitors will be required to write the final verse (beginning ‘Take up our quarrel...’) on the day in view of the judge. Maximum time allowed = 30 minutes

CLASS 8 – COOKERY

10:00AM

Open to one member per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors are required to make ‘A Welcome Home Tea for a Soldier’, using only ingredients from the weekly rations list below:

4oz Bacon or Ham
2oz Butter
2oz Cheese
4oz Margarine
4oz Cooking Fat
3 pints Milk
8oz Sugar
2oz Preserves
2oz Tea
1 Egg
12oz Sweets
1 Onion
1 tin of Spam or Corned Beef
1 Loaf of Brown Bread

Competitors are required to provide their own equipment, ingredients, etc. No items are to be prepared beforehand. No blow torches or cookers allowed. Display area = 68cm wide x 68cm deep x unlimited height. Maximum time allowed = 45 minutes.

Total marks = 100

CLASS 9 – BAKE OFF (staged)**9:30AM**

Open to two members per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors will be required to make and display 6 Rock Cakes. Competitors are required to display a recipe card showing ingredients and method. MAXIMUM space allowed 50cm x 50cm x unlimited height (this is to include the recipe card). All food items MUST be covered.

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 10 – METALWORK (staged)**9:30AM**

Open to one member per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors are required to make a 'Decorative Poppy'. Space allowed 80cm x 80cm x unlimited height. Items to be suitably displayed. Competitors will be required to provide a series of photos showing the stages of production of their work.

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 11 – CAKE DECORATING**12 NOON**

Open to one member per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors are required to decorate a cake or dummy to 'Celebrate 100 years of the Red Arrows'. The cake may be covered in fondant icing prior to the competition but no other decoration is to be added. MAXIMUM space allowed 45cm wide x 45cm deep x unlimited height. Maximum time allowed = 1hour

ON THE STAGE & AROUND THE SITE
"40 YEARS OF GREASE LIGHTNING"

CLASS 12 – DOUGH MODELLING**11:30PM**

Open to one member per club aged 16 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors to construct 'A Car from the film Grease (1978)' using only modelling dough. Competitors are to provide their own modelling dough. MAXIMUM space allowed 45cm wide x 45cm deep x unlimited height. Maximum time allowed = 45 minutes.

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 13 – GROUP ACTING**1:00PM**

Open to one team of between two and six competitors per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. AT LEAST one member per team is to be aged 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2018. Competitors will have up to 5 minutes on stage to act a scene from the film Grease (1978)

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 14 – DECORATE A SCARECROW (staged)**9:30AM**

Open to one member per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors are to produce a scarecrow of 'A Character from the film Grease (1978)'. The scarecrow must be free standing, and may be made in any medium. Maximum space allowed = 5ft high x 4ft wide x 2ft deep.

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 15 – GREASE CATWALK**2:30PM**

Open to one team of four competitors per club – one male and one female aged 26 and under on 1st September 2018 and 2 members aged 16 years and under on 1st September 2018. Junior competitors will be required to dress up their male team mate as a Pink Lady and their female team mate as a T-Bird, using recycled materials. The two members who have been dressed up will then be required to participate in a Catwalk. Maximum time allowed = 30 minutes, plus catwalk.

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 16 – SCAVENGER HUNT**12:30PM**

Open to two teams of two competitors per club aged 21 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors will be required to scavenge the show site for a list of items as supplied by the judge on the day. Maximum time allowed = 30 minutes. Marks will be awarded as follows:

Quickest time = 100 points, 2nd place = 95 points, etc to a minimum of 50 marks.

Competitors failing to find all of the items on the list will have marks deducted at a rate of 5 points per item, to a maximum loss of 50 points.

CLASS 17 – POT LUCK**1:30PM**

Open to one team of two competitors per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors will be required to report to the site office to receive instructions as to the competition.

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 18 – BALLOON MODELLING**12 NOON**

Open to one member per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors will be required to produce, on stage, a balloon model of their choice. Competitors to bring their own materials, equipment, etc. Maximum time allowed = 30 minutes

Total Marks: 100

CLASS 19 – GREASE KARAOKE**3:00PM**

Open to one team of up to six competitors per club aged 26 years and under on 1st September 2018. Competitors will be required to sing Karaoke to a Grease song of their choice.
