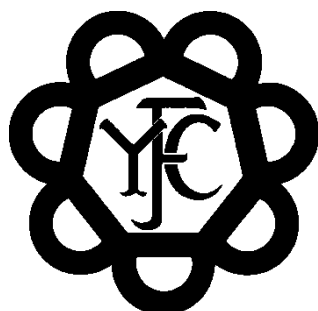

## COMPETITION RULES

## IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

Please read carefully and follow instructions clearly in order to avoid any mistakes or confusion.

a) Closing date for entries to be received at the County Office is:

**9PM ON MONDAY 1<sup>st</sup> JULY 2019. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

We realise that some of the names on your form may change after this date. Providing the changes are notified to the competition steward this will cause no problem.

- b) All competing members must have a **VALID CURRENT MEMBERSHIP CARD INCLUDING A PHOTO**. If new membership cards are required, the authorised membership forms must be received by the County Office no later than the deadline date above, along with the Entry Forms. Please note that all membership forms received at the office must be signed by the member, as well as a Parent/Guardian if under 18 and must be signed and dated by the authorised Club Officer.
- c) Two sets of schedules are enclosed for each Club. A booklet set is for the Club Secretary's reference and the A4 stapled set is for dismantling and passing on rules to the competing members, you may need to copy extra.
- d) One entry form is enclosed per Club. This is for completion and to be returned to the County Office by the deadline, you can make a copy for your records in the back of the booklet copy where the entry form is included or please ask for a spare form to fill in. You can also complete an online copy from email or the website.

All rules and entry forms are emailed to Club Chairmen and Secretaries in advance and posted out if not collected from the Office by a Club Representative.

- e) Any trophies relating to this competition held by any Club member must be returned to the County Office by the above deadline date, along with the entry form.
- f) Please make sure all competitors are aware of the competition rules and times.
- g) **HELPING MEMEBRS WITH ADDITIONAL PHYSICAL or LEARNING REQUIREMENTS.** HFYFC seeks the inclusion of the full membership in its endeavours. Should a member require assistance to compete at a County Final due to any additional physical or learning requirements, every effort shall be made to ensure inclusion of any member with dignity, respect and confidentiality. HFYFC requests prior knowledge of assistance required in order to maximize the benefit to the individual.

## HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules

- 1 The competitions listed herein are open to members of Herefordshire Federation of Young Farmers' Clubs (HFYFC) holding a valid, current YFC membership card. (Valid is classed as being of the correct year, having a signature and passport photograph of the member attached to the card.)
- 2 Any member who fails to produce a valid membership card will be able to purchase a temporary membership card from the office on the day, provided they are already a member. The card will cost £5 and will only be valid for the purpose of entering competitions on the day. Failure to produce a valid membership card will mean that the member will be unable to compete in the competition.
- 3 All of the following competitions are open to members 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2017, and 10 years of age or over on the day of the competition.
- 4 Where more than one entry per club is allowed in a competition, only the points of the highest scoring entry will count towards the cups and trophies.
- 5 Health and Safety requirements must be adhered to at all times.
- 6 Competitors must act in accordance with HFYFC policies, where applicable.
- 7 No alcohol is to be consumed by competitors before or during competitions. Any member judged to be under the influence of alcohol or any other substance will not be permitted to continue with the competition and may be disqualified.
- 8 The use of mobile phones during competitions is prohibited.
- 9 A white coat must be worn where specified.
- 10 All work must be that of the competitor who has booked in, if not the competitor they must have the competitors card.
- 11 All work must have been made in the last 12 months by members 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2018.
- 12 Competitors must arrive on time and report to the competition steward **before** the start time of the competition to book in with necessary equipment to complete the competition.
- 13 In the event of a conflict between the competition rules and the general rules, the competition rules will govern.
- 14 All staged items must remain the responsibility of the competitor. Neither HFYFC nor the site host accepts any liability for loss, damage or theft of any item.
- 15 No staged items or exhibits can be removed before prize giving, at penalty of disqualification.
- 16 For entries not according to schedule, 25% of marks awarded will be deducted. This includes any exhibits oversize.
- 17 The Chief Steward and Competitions Chairman reserve the right to cancel or amend any competition or rule at any time.
- 18 In all competitions the decision of the Chief Steward and the Competitions Chairman will be **final**.
- 19 In competitions with time limits, the following marks will be deducted if the competitor overruns (unless otherwise stated):

Competition Length	Penalty
Up to 30 minutes	5% of total marks per minute or part thereof.
31 to 60 minutes	5% of total marks per two minutes or part thereof.
61 to 120 minutes	5% of total marks per five minutes or part thereof.
121 minutes and over	5% of total marks per ten minutes or part thereof.



## Class 5: Junior Exhibit

**Time:** To be staged by 10:30am ready for judging.

**Entries:** Open to ONE (1) entry per Club. Competitors to be 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition. Any number of members may contribute.

<b>Marks:</b>	Quality & Depth of Research	50
	5 items of Different Crafts (20 points each)	100
	Additional Craft Items	40

**Rules:**

- 1 Each exhibit to depict the theme “**WWII**”. The interpretation of the theme is to be of the club’s own choice
- 2 Each exhibit to have a **MAXIMUM SIZE of 1829mm x 685mm**. Maximum height of the exhibit is 1020mm from the tabletop. The Exhibit is to be staged on a table provided. The front of the table may be covered and can be used as part of the exhibit. Any exhibit exceeding the maximum measurements will be penalised according to the HFYFC General Rules. Exhibits will be measured by the competition steward.
- 3 A list of all items made by the competitors is to be attached to the Exhibit for the purpose of assisting judging. Five different crafts are to be clearly marked 1 to 5 so that the judges can award points for these individually. It is expected that further craft items will be included in the exhibit and judged as per the mark scheme. All crafts must have been made during the past 12 months by members 16 years of age or under. Craft items must not have been used at a previous Junior Field Day.
- 4 Items of cookery will only be tasted at the discretion of the judges. All foodstuffs to be covered with cling film.
- 5 Battery power is allowed for powering items within the exhibit. However, the use of car batteries is NOT allowed.
- 6 No names of clubs or counties to be marked on any exhibits
- 7 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

## Information for Subsequent Rounds

**Representation:**

The top 2 placed entries at the county round will be requested to compete again in the Three Counties round at the Royal Three Counties Show in June 2020.

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- 4 Where more than one entry per club is allowed in a competition, only the points of the highest scoring entry will count towards the cups and trophies.
- 5 Health and Safety requirements must be adhered to at all times.
- 6 Competitors must act in accordance with HFYFC policies, where applicable.
- 7 No alcohol is to be consumed by competitors before or during competitions. Any member judged to be under the influence of alcohol or any other substance will not be permitted to continue with the competition and may be disqualified.
- 8 The use of mobile phones during competitions is prohibited.

**Entries:** Open to ONE (1) competitor per club 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

**Rules:**

- 1 Competitors will be required to make and suitably display **“A Picnic Hamper suitable for A Day at the Races”**
- 2 The Picnic Hamper to contain a **MAXIMUM** of:  
**3 Savoury Items**  
**2 Sweet Items**  
**1 Non-Alcoholic Drink**  
All of the items in the Picnic Hamper are to be homemade in advance by the competitor. Edible items should be covered prior to judging, and will be tasted by the judge
- 3 Competitors must display a list of the items within the Hamper
- 4 **Maximum Display Area 500mm x 500mm.** There is no height limit
- 5 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

<b>Marks:</b>	Originality	35
	Design	45

**Rules:**

- 1 Competitors will be required to design a “Polo Shirt to commemorate the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of HFYFC” in 2019.
- 2 The design should show the front, back and sleeves of the Polo Shirt, and the HFYFC Logo **MUST** be included in the design
- 3 Designs can be done using a computer programme or by hand, and should be presented on **A3** paper, card or board
- 4 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

## Class 8: Woodwork

**Time:** To be staged by 10:30am ready for judging.

**Entries:** Open to TWO (2) competitors per club 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

<b>Marks:</b>	Construction	40
	Design	40
	Finish	20
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

**Rules:**

- 1 Competitors will be required to make and bring to the competition a **“Shoe Rack”** made out of wood
- 2 Design to be the competitor’s own choice
- 3 **Maximum size 1000mm wide x 1000mm deep x 1000mm high**
- 4 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

## Class 9: Photography

**Time:** To be staged by 10:30am ready for judging.

**Entries:** Open to TWO (2) competitors per club 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

<b>Marks:</b>	Photographs (20 points each)	60
	Display	20
	Relevance to Theme	20
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

**Rules:**

- 1 Competitors will be required to take and display 3 photographs, **150mm x 100mm (6" x 4")**, mounted on an **A3 board** to the theme **"On the Pitch"**
- 2 Photographs can be captured using film or digital photography.
- 3 If digital photography is used as the capture method the photographs **MUST NOT** be digitally enhanced using photographic software on a computer. The preferred printing method would be to print the photos from the memory card using a commercial photo machine.
- 4 If a photo machine is used the appropriate size can be selected and the image can be turned into black & white, sepia or colour but no other alterations can be done for example cropping images, brightness/contrast, colour restoration/balance or any method which would digitally alter the photo quality.
- 5 Photos should be self-explanatory but a short sentence or title under each photo would be allowed (10 words maximum) or a three sentence script (30 words maximum) anywhere on the A3 board. Text should be separate and **NOT** within a photograph or this will be perceived as being digitally enhanced.
- 6 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

## Class 10: Baking

**Time:** To be staged by 10:30am ready for judging.

**Entries:** Open to TWO (2) competitors per club 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

<b>Marks:</b>	Finished Scones (overall bake)	50
	Taste	25
	Display	25
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

**Rules:**

**1** The competitor is required to make and suitably display “**Six (6) Plain Scones**” using the recipe specified below. **Competitors to display the scones with their choice of accompaniments – jam, cream, butter, etc**

**2** Recipe

450g self raising flour  
2 level tsp baking powder  
50g caster sugar  
100g butter (softened, cut into pieces)  
2 eggs  
A little milk

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 220C/200C Fan/Gas 7.
  2. Lightly grease two baking trays.
  3. Put the flour, baking powder and sugar in a large bowl.
  4. Add the butter and rub in with your fingertips until the mixture resembles fine breadcrumbs.
  5. Crack the eggs into a measuring jug, then add enough milk to make the total liquid 300ml/10fl oz.
  6. Stir the egg and milk into the flour – you may not need it all – and mix to a soft, sticky dough.
  7. Turn out onto a lightly floured work surface, knead lightly, if using. Roll out to a rectangle about 2cm/¾in thick.
  8. Cut into as many rounds as possible with a fluted 5cm/2in cutter and place them on the prepared baking trays.
  9. Brush the tops of the scones with a little extra milk, or any egg and milk left in the jug.
  10. Bake for 12–15 minutes, or until the scones are well risen and a pale, golden-brown colour. Lift onto a wire rack to cool.
- 3** To be suitably displayed in a **maximum space of 400mm x 400mm**. There is no height limit
- 4** The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

**Entries:** Open to TWO (2) competitors per club 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

<b>Marks:</b>	Use of Materials	20
	Quality of Workmanship	20
	Originality	30
	Overall Finish	30
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

**Rules:**

- 1 The competitor is required to produce a “**Sports Stadium Diorama**”
- 2 A Diorama to be displayed to depict a Sports Stadium. A table will be available to display the craft. The choice of materials is the competitor’s own.
- 3 Battery power is allowed for powering items within the exhibit, however the use of 12volt batteries is not permitted on any part of the exhibit.
- 4 The exhibit should be a **MAXIMUM size of 900mm x 600mm**, no maximum height
- 5 The exhibit should be suitable for a family audience
- 4 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

<b>Marks:</b>	Choice of Fabric	25
	Constructions and Sewing Skills	50
	Overall Appearance	25
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

**Rules:**

- 1 The competitor is required to make and suitably display a “**Supporters Scarf**”
- 2 The scarf can be made from any type of material or fabric and can be machine or hand sewn
- 3 The display area **must not exceed 1200mm x 1200mm**, no maximum height
- 4 No names of clubs to be marks on any exhibits
- 5 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition
