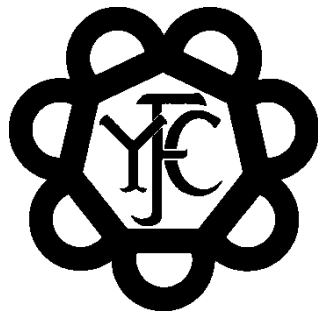

## COMPETITION RULES

## IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

Please read carefully and follow instructions clearly in order to avoid any mistakes or confusion.

a) Closing date for entries to be received at the County Office is:

**9PM ON MONDAY 4<sup>th</sup> JULY 2022. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

We realise that some of the names on your form may change after this date. Providing the changes are notified to the competition steward this will cause no problem.

- b) All competing members must have a **VALID CURRENT MEMBERSHIP CARD INCLUDING A PHOTO**. If new membership cards are required, the authorised membership forms must be received by the County Office no later than the deadline date above, along with the Entry Forms. Please note that all membership forms received at the office must be signed by the member, as well as a Parent/Guardian if under 18 and must be signed and dated by the authorised Club Officer.
- c) Two sets of schedules are enclosed for each Club. A booklet set is for the Club Secretary's reference and the A4 stapled set is for dismantling and passing on rules to the competing members, you may need to copy extra.
- d) One entry form is enclosed per Club. This is for completion and to be returned to the County Office by the deadline, you can make a copy for your records in the back of the booklet copy where the entry form is included or please ask for a spare form to fill in. You can also complete an online copy from email or the website.

All rules and entry forms are emailed to Club Chairmen and Secretaries in advance and posted out if not collected from the Office by a Club Representative.

- e) Any trophies relating to this competition held by any Club member must be returned to the County Office by the above deadline date, along with the entry form.
- f) Please make sure all competitors are aware of the competition rules and times.
- g) **HELPING MEMBERS WITH ADDITIONAL PHYSICAL or LEARNING REQUIREMENTS.** HFYFC seeks the inclusion of the full membership in its endeavours. Should a member require assistance to compete at a County Final due to any additional physical or learning requirements, every effort shall be made to ensure inclusion of any member with dignity, respect and confidentiality. HFYFC requests prior knowledge of assistance required in order to maximize the benefit to the individual.

## HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules

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- 2 Any member who fails to produce a valid membership card will be able to purchase a temporary membership card from the office on the day, provided they are already a member. The card will cost £5 and will only be valid for the purpose of entering competitions on the day. Failure to produce a valid membership card will mean that the member will be unable to compete in the competition.
- 3 All of the following competitions are open to members 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2021, and 10 years of age or over on the day of the competition.
- 4 Where more than one entry per club is allowed in a competition, only the points of the highest scoring entry will count towards the cups and trophies.
- 5 Health and Safety requirements must be adhered to at all times.
- 6 Competitors must act in accordance with HFYFC policies, where applicable.
- 7 No alcohol is to be consumed by competitors before or during competitions. Any member judged to be under the influence of alcohol or any other substance will not be permitted to continue with the competition and may be disqualified.
- 8 The use of mobile phones during competitions is prohibited.
- 9 A white coat must be worn where specified.
- 10 All work must be that of the competitor who has booked in, if not the competitor they must have the competitor's card.
- 11 All work must have been made in the last 12 months by members 16 years of age or under on 1st September 2021.
- 12 Competitors must arrive on time and report to the competition steward **before** the start time of the competition to book in with necessary equipment to complete the competition.
- 13 In the event of a conflict between the competition rules and the general rules, the competition rules will govern.
- 14 All staged items must remain the responsibility of the competitor. Neither HFYFC nor the site host accepts any liability for loss, damage or theft of any item.
- 15 No staged items or exhibits can be removed before prize giving, at penalty of disqualification.
- 16 For entries not according to schedule, 25% of marks awarded will be deducted. This includes any exhibits oversize.
- 17 The Chief Steward and Competitions Chairman reserve the right to cancel or amend any competition or rule at any time.
- 18 In all competitions the decision of the Chief Steward and the Competitions Chairman will be **final**.
- 19 In competitions with time limits, the following marks will be deducted if the competitor overruns (unless otherwise stated):

Competition Length	Penalty
Up to 30 minutes	5% of total marks per minute or part thereof.
31 to 60 minutes	5% of total marks per two minutes or part thereof.
61 to 120 minutes	5% of total marks per five minutes or part thereof.
121 minutes and over	5% of total marks per ten minutes or part thereof.

## Class 5: Junior Exhibit

**Time:** To be staged by 10:30am ready for judging.

**Entries:** Open to ONE (1) entry per Club. Competitors to be 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition. Any number of members may contribute.

<b>Marks:</b>	Quality & Depth of Research	50
	5 items of Different Crafts (20 points each)	100

### **Rules:**

- 1 Each exhibit to depict the theme “**Emergency Services**”. The interpretation of the theme is to be of the club’s own choice.
- 2 Each exhibit to have a **MAXIMUM SIZE of 1829mm (w) x 685mm (d)**. Maximum height of the exhibit is 1020mm from the tabletop. The Exhibit is to be staged on a table provided. The front of the table may be covered and can be used as part of the exhibit. Any exhibit exceeding the maximum measurements will be penalised according to the HFYFC General Rules. Exhibits will be measured by the competition steward.
- 3 A list of all items made by the competitors is to be attached to the Exhibit for the purpose of assisting judging. Five different crafts are to be clearly marked 1 to 5 so that the judges can award points for these individually. It is expected that further craft items will be included in the exhibit and judged as per the mark scheme. All crafts must have been made during the past 12 months by members 16 years of age or under. Craft items must not have been used at a previous Junior Field Day or Pre-Rally in 2022.
- 4 Items of cookery will only be tasted at the discretion of the judges. All foodstuffs to be covered with cling film.
- 5 Battery power is allowed for powering items within the exhibit. However, the use of car batteries is NOT allowed.
- 6 No names of clubs or counties to be marked on any exhibits
- 7 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

## Information for Subsequent Rounds

### **Representation:**

The top 2 placed entries at the county round will be requested to compete again in the Three Counties round at the Royal Three Counties Show in June 2023.

1 Competitors will be required to make and suitably display **"A Hero's Lunch"**

2 The lunch is to contain a **MINIMUM** of:

**2 Savoury Items**

**2 Sweet Items**

**1 Non-Alcoholic Drink**

All of the items in the lunch are to be homemade in advance by the competitor. Edible items should be covered prior to judging, and will be tasted by the judge

3 Competitors must display a list of the items within the Hamper

4 **Maximum Display Area 680mm x 680mm.** There is no height limit

5 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

**Entries:** Open to TWO (2) competitors per club 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

**Rules:**

- 1 Competitors will be required to make and bring to the competition a **“Medical Themed Planter”** made out of wood
- 2 Design to be the competitor’s own choice
- 3 **Maximum size 1000mm wide x 1000mm deep x 1000mm high**
- 4 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

## Class 8: Photography

**Time:** To be staged by 10:30am ready for judging.

**Entries:** Open to TWO (2) competitors per club 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

<b>Marks:</b>	Finished Album Cover (Overall Photography Skills)	40
	Display	20
	Relevance to original album cover	40
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

**Rules:**

- 1 Competitors will be required to display a **'Recreation of an Album Cover'**. The album cover must be **150mm x 150mm (6" x 6")**
- 2 The album cover can be any medium but should not include photoshop
- 3 A copy of the original album cover that is being recreated must be supplied. The album cover used must be suitable for a listener of anyone over the age of 10.
- 4 The Recreated Album Cover and Original must be presented on A3 Card or Mount board
- 5 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

## Class 9: Baking

**Time:** To be staged by 10:30am ready for judging.

**Entries:** Open to TWO (2) competitors per club 16 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

<b>Marks:</b>	Finished Baked Cheesecake (overall bake)	50
	Taste	25
	Display	25
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

**Rules:**

1 The competitor is required to make and suitably display a **“Baked Cheesecake”** using the recipe specified below. **Competitors to display the baked cheesecake with their choice of accompaniments – cream, compote, fresh fruit etc**

2 **Recipe**

150g Digestive Biscuits  
75g Butter, plus extra for greasing  
900g Full-Fat Cream Cheese  
200g Caster Sugar  
200ml Soured Cream  
3tbsp Plain Flour  
3 Eggs, plus 1 egg yolk, lightly beaten  
2tsp Vanilla Extract

**Method**

- 1) Preheat the oven to 180°C, fan, gas 4. Grease and line a 23cm round, spring form tin.
- 2) Place the biscuits in a plastic bag and crush with a rolling pin, to fine crumbs.
- 3) Melt the butter and add the biscuit crumbs, stir to combine. Place in the base of the cake tin and spread in an even layer, then flatten.
- 4) Bake in the oven for 10 minutes until golden. Remove and leave to cool while you prepare the filling.
- 5) Reduce the oven to 160°C, gas 2.
- 6) In a large bowl, beat together the cream cheese and sugar until smooth, then add the sour cream, and flour and beat again. Gradually add the eggs and vanilla extract, beating well between each addition (beat in rather than whisk as you don't want to incorporate too much air as this will affect the smooth surface of cheesecake).
- 7) Pour the cream cheese mix on to the biscuit base then bake in the oven for 45minutes. The cheesecake should be just set with a slight wobble and should still be cream on top with just a slight golden hint around the edges.
- 8) Once the cheesecake is cooked, turn off the oven and prop open the door so that it is slightly ajar and leave the cheesecake to cool in the oven – this prevents the top from cracking.
- 9) Once the oven is cool you can remove the cheesecake to cool completely before removing from the tin.

3 To be suitably displayed in a **maximum space of 400mm x 400mm**. There is no height limit

**Rules:**

- 1** The competitor is required to produce an "Emergency Vehicle" out of Papier Mache
- 2** This is to be made prior to the competition day  
At least four photographs should be provided to show the different stages of constructing the Papier Mache Emergency Vehicle
- 3** The exhibit should be a **MAXIMUM size of 500mm x 500mm**, no maximum height  
A table will be provided to display the craft
- 4** The exhibit should be suitable for a family audience
- 5** The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

**Rules:**

- 1 Competitors will be required to design a **“Polo Shirt for the Junior Forum members”**.
- 2 The design should show the front, back and sleeves of the Polo Shirt, and the HFYFC Logo **MUST** be included in the design
- 3 Designs can be done using a computer programme or by hand, and should be presented on **A3** paper, card or board
- 4 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition
- 5 The winner of the competition may get their design printed and sold to members of the Junior Forum

	Constructions and Sewing Skills	50

**Rules:**

- 1 The competitor is required to make and suitably display a “**Emergency Services Themed Bunting**”
- 2 The bunting can be made from any type of material or fabric and can be machine or hand sewn
- 3 The display area **must not exceed 1500mm x 1500mm**, no maximum height
- 4 No names of clubs to be marks on any exhibits
- 5 The HFYFC Junior Field Day General Rules apply to this competition

If the pan support is upside down and the burner is used, heat can be transferred onto the aerosol type butane canister in the body of the stove and after a time, the canister can burst causing a violent fire.

**D** Ensure that the correct type of gas canister for the appliance is used and that it is correctly fitted (in the right place and in the right way).

**E** When fitting the butane canister, do not force the gas canister retaining lever into position as this can damage the mechanical linkage and the safety pressure relief device. If there is a problem with the retaining lever, check that the pan support and spill tray and the butane gas canister has been correctly fitted. If there is still a problem with the lever or if there are further problems or concerns, do not attempt to ignite the stove.

**F** If anyone smells or hears gas leaking from the stove before attempting to light it, don't use it & inform an official.
