## GENERAL RULES

1. All competitors must be current (2022-23) members of Herefordshire or Radnorshire YFC's. Competitors will be required to show their membership cards. Failure to do so will result in a £5 on the spot penalty charge.
2. A white coat must be worn, unless otherwise specified. Competitors not wearing white coats when they should be will be deducted 10 points from their final mark.
3. For the purposes of this schedule, the following age limits will apply:  
Senior – open to member 28 years of age and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022  
Intermediate – open to members 21 years of age and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022  
Junior – open to members 16 years of age and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022, and 10 years of age or over on the day of the competition.
4. All members must have valid membership cards with photo and signature. Members with cards that have expired or with no photo will not be allowed to compete (for insurance reasons).
5. Competitors must arrive on time and report to the competition steward before the start time of the competition to book in with necessary equipment to complete the competition. See rule 6 regarding the procedure if a competitor is going to be late to their competition. Any competitor arriving late without prior notification may be penalised, at the discretion of the judge.
6. Each club is to appoint their own Chief Steward – a non-competing person who will be responsible for informing competition Stewards and Announcers if a competitor is late reporting for a competition or won't be reporting at all. This person's name and contact details are to be included on the entry form.
7. Special requirements – if any member has any special requirements when competing, then please do not hesitate to contact the County Office in order that the necessary provisions may be implemented, ideally at least a week prior to the competition.
8. Competitors may not communicate with each other or with members of the public whilst competitions are ongoing or whilst in the stockjudging rings, at penalty of disqualification. Competitors will receive one warning from the steward, after which any incident shall be reported to the judge.
9. In all competitions, the decision of the judge is final. No harassment may be given to the judge or steward by any YFC member or member of the public, at penalty of disqualification.
10. All trestle tables will be 6 or 8 foot.
11. All exhibits must be left on view to the public until 5pm, when they can be removed. If removed before 5pm, clubs will be placed 20 points below the lowest placed club in that competition.
12. Herefordshire and Radnorshire Federations will not be held responsible for any items left on display after 6pm.
13. Members turning up late for the first competition of the day will be given no extra time to complete the competition. There will be zero tolerance on this rule.
14. No electric will be available for competitors on the day.

## RULES REGARDING TOTAL DISQUALIFICATION

- A) If a competitor is found to be over the stated age, this will lead to total disqualification
- B) The County Chairman, County Vice-Chairman, Competitions Chairman and Competition Vice-Chairman have the right to disqualify any competitor they feel is under the influence of alcohol or other substances.
- C) Any infringement of the rules will result in a competitor being placed at the bottom with a difference of 10 points to the next highest placed competitor.
- D) Any complaints to be received in writing by the Competitions Chairman and accompanied by £20 within one hour of the alleged grievance. A panel of the County Chairman, County Vice-Chairman, Competitions Chairman, Competitions Vice-Chairman and the competition judges(s) and steward(s) (if available) will give ruling. If the complaint is upheld the £20 will be refunded.

## AWARDS

**The Major HEB Holden Perpetual Challenge Cup** will be awarded to the club gaining the highest aggregate marks in all competitions.

**The Messrs J & P Turner Ltd Perpetual Challenge Cup** will be awarded to the winning team in class 1.

**The Hector Morris Challenge Cup** will be awarded to the club gaining the highest aggregate marks in the home craft section (classes 3, 4, 5, 10, 11, 12, 13)

**Prize Cards** will be awarded to the 3 highest placed scorers in each competition.

## ENTRY FEE & FORMS

An **Entry Fee of £25.00** entitles a club to enter all classes and is to be sent with the entry form to Herefordshire YFC Office.

## COMPETITION RULES

### **CLASS 1 STOCKJUDGING – BEEF CATTLE**

**9:30AM**

Open to one team of two competitors per club, one aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 and one aged 18 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Each competitor will be required to judge one ring of FOUR BUTCHERS BEASTS and place in order of merit. The animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. Competitors will be allowed 10 minutes to view, handle and place in the ring, and 2 minutes to state their reasons to the judge. 2 marks per 15 seconds (or part thereof) will be deducted from the total score if this time limit is exceeded.

### **CLASS 2 STOCKJUDGING – SHEEP**

**9:30AM**

Open to one team of two competitors per club, one aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 and one aged 18 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Each competitor will be required to judge one ring of FOUR FAT LAMBS and place in order of merit. The animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. Competitors will be allowed 10 minutes to view, handle and place in the ring, and 2 minutes to state their reasons to the judge. 2 marks per 15 seconds (or part thereof) will be deducted from the total score if this time limit is exceeded.

**CLASS 4 – HANDWRITING**

**10:30AM**

Open to one member per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors are required to hand write the first 2 verses of the Hometown Heroes by Matt Windle on A4 paper or card prior to the competition day. Competitors will be required to write the final verse (beginning ‘We witness a rebuilding of the bridges..’) on the day in view of the judge. Maximum time allowed = 30 minutes

**CLASS 5 – BAKE OFF – A Decorated Pavlova (staged)**

**9:30AM**

Open to two members per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors will be required to make and display a Decorated Pavlova. Competitors are required to display a recipe card showing ingredients and method. MAXIMUM space allowed 50cm x 50cm x unlimited height (this is to include the recipe card). All food items MUST be covered.

**CLASS 6 – METALWORK – Commonwealth Queen’s Baton (staged)**

**9:30AM**

Open to one member per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors are required to make a ‘Commonwealth Queen’s Baton’. Space allowed 80cm x 80cm x unlimited height. Items to be suitably displayed. Competitors will be required to provide a series of photos showing the stages of production of their work.

Open to one member per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors are to produce a scarecrow of ‘A Famous Athlete’. The scarecrow must be free standing, and may be made in any medium. Maximum space allowed = 5ft high x 4ft wide x 2ft deep.

Open to ONE member per club, 28 years of age and under on the 1st September 2022. Competitors to create a Promotional poster for 'Love Lamb Week' which is the 1<sup>st</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> September annually. Size: A4.

**CLASS 9 – UPCYCLED FAMOUS COMMONWEALTH LANDMARK (staged)****9.30AM**

Open to ONE member per club, 28 years of age and under on the 1st September 2022. Competitors are required to make an "Upcycled Famous Commonwealth Landmark" out of bottles, cans and cardboard. Joining materials and decoration do not need to be upcycled. To be made prior to the competition day. At least four photographs should be provided to show the different stages of constructing the Upcycled Famous Commonwealth Landmark. Only a table will be available to display the craft, stand should be provided by the competitor if desired. The exhibit should be a **MAXIMUM** size of **600mm(D) x 600mm(W), 1000mm(H)**. No names of clubs or counties to appear on any exhibits. All exhibits must be the unaided work of the competitors

**CLASS 10 – UNDER 18 FLORAL ART – My Favourite Commonwealth Sport****11:00AM**

Open to one member per club aged 18 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors will be required to make an exhibit to the theme 'My Favourite Commonwealth Sport', to be viewed from the front. Maximum space allowed = 60cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height. An Exhibit to compose of natural plant material with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified above. All arrangements to be assembled during the competition. Competitors to bring their own materials, equipment, etc. Maximum time allowed = 60 minutes, with a further 10 minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during clearing-up.

Competitors may spend a **MAXIMUM** of £25 on flowers, and receipts must be displayed on the exhibit.

**CLASS 11 – UNDER 28 FLORAL ART – Celebrating Commonwealth Countries****11:00AM**

Open to one member per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors will be required to make an exhibit to the theme 'Celebrating Commonwealth Countries'. Maximum space allowed = 60cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height. An Exhibit to compose of natural plant material with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified above. All arrangements to be assembled during the competition. Competitors to bring their own materials, equipment, etc. Maximum time allowed = 60 minutes, with a further 10 minutes to check that arrangements have not been disturbed during clearing-up.

Competitors may spend a **MAXIMUM** of £25 on flowers, and receipts must be displayed on the exhibit.

**CLASS 12 – COOKERY – Canapes for the VIP Reception at the Opening Ceremony****10:00AM**

Open to one member per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors are required to make Canapes for a 'VIP Reception at the Opening Ceremony'. Competitors are required to provide their own equipment, ingredients, etc. These ingredients should be locally sourced and British produce where possible. No items are to be prepared beforehand. No blow torches or cookers allowed. Display area = 68cm wide x 68cm deep x unlimited height. Maximum time allowed = 45 minutes.

**CLASS 13 – CAKE DECORATING – Flags of the Commonwealth****12 NOON**

Open to one member per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors are required to decorate a cake or dummy to the theme 'Flags of the Commonwealth'. The cake may be covered in fondant icing prior to the competition but no other decoration is to be added. MAXIMUM space allowed 45cm wide x 45cm deep x unlimited height. Maximum time allowed = 1hour

**CLASS 14 – DRESS UP AS PERRY (Commonwealth Mascot)****12 NOON**

Open to ONE (1) team per club. A team shall consist of **THREE (3)** competitors, one 28 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 and two 21 years of age or under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022, and all 10 years or over on the day of the competition. Teams are required to work together to dress one member as '**Perry**' (**Commonwealth Mascot**) using only recycled material. Time allowed = **maximum of 30 minutes**. The member dressed up will then be required to partake in a catwalk style show. This should be suitable for a family audience. All materials are to be supplied by members of the team. No items to be pre-made, all outfits to be made and assembled on the day.

**CLASS 15 – SCAVENGER HUNT****12:30PM**

Open to two teams of two competitors per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors will be required to scavenge the show site for a list of items as supplied by the Judge on the day. Maximum time allowed = 30 minutes.

**CLASS 16 – POT LUCK****1:30PM**

Open to one team of two competitors per club aged 28 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. Competitors will be required to report to the site office to receive instructions as to the competition.

**CLASS 17 – HAKA****1:30PM**

Open to ONE (1) team per club. A team shall consist of a **minimum of TWO (2)** and a **maximum of SIX (6)** competitors aged 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2022 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

The team is required to perform a '**Haka**', which is suitable for a family audience. Competitors to provide their own equipment. The performance is to take place on a staged area **6m x 6m**. The Haka to be a **minimum of 2 minutes** and a **maximum of 5 minutes** in length. Time penalties of one mark per thirty seconds or part thereof above this time. This time does not include setting and dismantling of the stage.

**CLASS 18 – PERFORMANCE FOR CLOSING CEREMONY****1:30PM**

Open to ONE (1) team per club. A team shall consist of a **minimum of ONE (1)** and a **maximum of FIVE (5)** competitors 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2022 and 10 years or over on the day of the competition.

The team is required to do a performance suitable for the Closing Ceremony, which is suitable for a family audience.

The show to be a **minimum of 2 minutes** and a **maximum of 5 minutes** in length. Time penalties of one mark per thirty seconds or part thereof outside of this time. This does not include setting and dismantling of stage. The performance is to take place on a staged area **6m x 6m**.

**CLASS 19 – What’s in the Hay Net?****1:30PM**

Open to TWO (2) members per Club. Both 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2022, and 10 years or over on the day of the competition. Competitors will be required to talk about a random object picked from a bag for 1 minute.
